

Case Study for Treatment of Stretch Marks

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Profile

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Introduction:

Female, 33 years old, Skin Type III, with stretch marks that appeared on the buttocks during youth at age 14.

Discussion:

A series of treatments with the Lux1540™ were provided.

1st treatment: February 2009, 10 mm tip
45 mj/mb, 15 ms, 2 passes

2nd treatment: March 2009, 10 mm tip
45 mj/mb, 15 ms, 2 passes

3rd treatment: April 2009, 10 mm tip
45 mj/mb, 15 ms, 2 passes

Conclusion:

The patient received three treatments spaced three to four weeks apart. The example below illustrates the excellent results achieved using the 1540 nm laser treatment for well aged striae albae. I have now followed the patient for up to 12 months and observed no recurrence of striae. I am unable to recognize some thin striae on the treated area.

Patient Observation: The patient reported improvements up to 50% in the appearance of her striae and was satisfied with the results.

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
